## AMENDED ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine "there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed." Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is "other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed," Hon. Hon. Milas H. "Butch" Hale, 31<sup>st</sup> Judicial District Court, Sherwood District Court, is hereby assigned to the Little Rock District Court, Department 1, to hear the following cases:

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connections with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Hale.

The assignment of Judge Hale to the Little Rock District Court, Department 1, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Sherwood District Court, shall remain in Judge Hale to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
