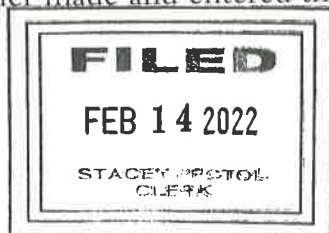
ORDER


The Pulaski County Circuit Clerk, has requested assignment of a special judge under Section 13 C of Amendment 80, which provides for “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Cathleen Compton has jury trials scheduled in Pulaski County, which will conflict with her regularly scheduled docket in the same county. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge Chris Piazza, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 6th Judicial Circuit, 3rd Division, to sit on the following dates:

March 1-3, 2022

On that date, Judge Piazza will assume Judge Compton’s regularly scheduled docket while Judge Compton presides over jury trials in the same county and the same circuit.
