State of Arkansas v. Kristi Johnson – ADS-26-88

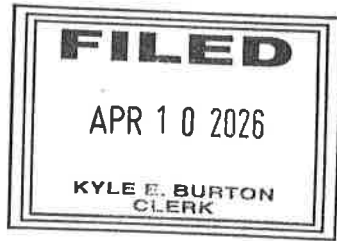
State of Arkansas v. Robert Johnson – ADS-26-89

Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Howard County, Little River County, Pike County, and Sevier County District Courts, Division 1, shall remain in Judge Wood to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
