ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Little River County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Many Wood, Sevier County District Court, DeQueen Department, is hereby assigned to the Little River County District Court, Ashdown Department, to hear the following case:

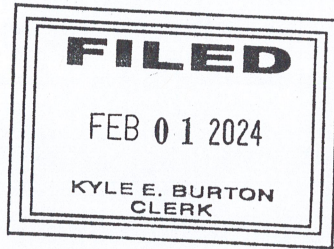


The assignment of Judge Wood to the Little River County District Court, Ashdown Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Little River County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Wood.

The assignment of Judge Wood to the Little River County District Court, Ashdown Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Sevier County District Court, DeQueen Department, shall remain in Judge Wood to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
