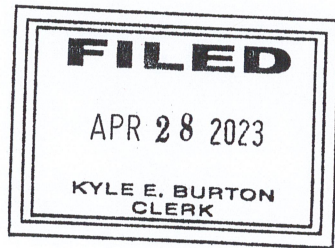
The assignment of Judge Stidham to the Randolph County District Court, Pocahontas Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Stidham.

The assignment of Judge Stidham to the Randolph County District Court, Pocahontas Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Clay County and Greene County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Stidham to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
