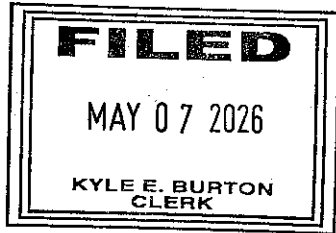
James Colt v. Tate's Minute Mechanic, RA Larry Tate – SC-26-7
