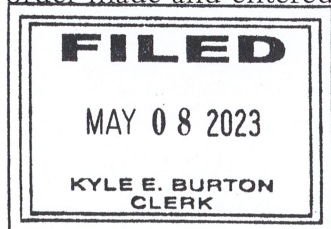
## ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Judge Jim Andrews is presiding over some criminal cases in Union County and has his regular scheduled criminal docket in Union County on the same date and time. Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Judge Michael Landers, Retired Circuit Judge, is hereby assigned to the 13<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit, 4<sup>th</sup> Division, to sit on the following date:

June 6, 2023

On that date, Judge Landers will cover the criminal docket in Union County while Judge Andrews will cover the criminal cases in Union County in the same circuit.
