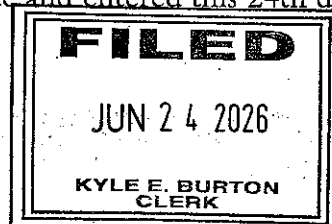
## ORDER
