Randy Hill, State District Court Judge, 40th Judicial District Court, Clark County District Court, is hereby assigned to the Garland County District Court, Hot Spring Department, to hear the following case:


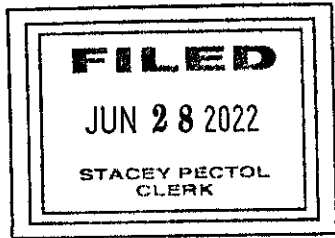
Christopher J. Skeya v. Delta M. Queen – HTSC-22-7

The assignment of Judge Hill to the Garland County District Court, Hot Springs Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date due to the Garland County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Hill.

The assignment of Judge Hill to the Garland County District Court, Hot Springs Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Clark County District Court, shall remain in Judge Hill to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
