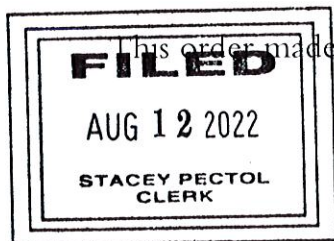

## ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Hon. B. Park Eldridge, Arkansas County District Court, DeWitt, Gillett, and St. Charles Departments, is hereby assigned to the Arkansas County District Court, Stuttgart Department, to sit on the following date:

September 13, 2022

The assignment of Judge Eldridge to the Arkansas County District Court, Stuttgart Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Arkansas County District Court, DeWitt, Gillett, and St. Charles Departments, shall remain in Judge Eldridge to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
