

## ORDER

Under Section 13C of Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, a special judge may be assigned if the Chief Justice shall determine “there is other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed.” Therefore, under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965 as amended, and Ark. Const. Amend. 80, and because the Chief Justice has determined there is “other need for a Special Judge to be temporarily appointed,” Hon. John Martin, Monroe County District Court, Brinkley Department, is hereby assigned to the Monroe County District Court, Clarendon Department, to sit on the following dates:

September 1, 2022  
October 6 and 20, 2022

The assignment of Judge Martin to the Monroe County District Court, Clarendon Department, entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Monroe County District Court, Brinkley Department, shall remain in Judge Martin to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
