Jodi Carney, 10th Judicial District Court, Baxter County and Marion County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Boone County District Court, Harrison Department, to hear the following cases:

DWI-23-16; CR-23-368

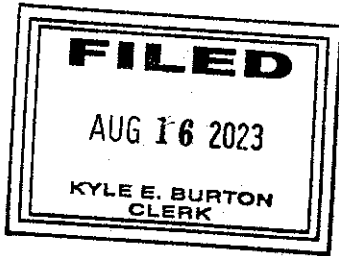


This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Carney.

The assignment of Judge Carney to the Boone County District Court, Harrison Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Baxter County and Marion County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Carney to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
