Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Randolph County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Jodi Carney, 10th Judicial District Court, Baxter County and Marion County District Courts, is hereby assigned to the Randolph County District Court, Pocahontas Department, to hear the following case:

State of Arkansas v. Heather R. King – CR-23-1875

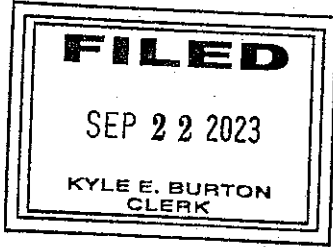


This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Carney.

The assignment of Judge Carney to the Randolph County District Court, Pocahontas Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Baxter County and Marion County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Carney to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
