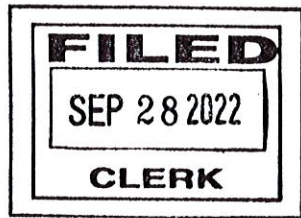
The assignment of Judge Ramsey to the Washington County District Court, Springdale Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the conflict date, due to the Washington County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as

shall be directed and ordered by Judge Ramsey.

The assignment of Judge Ramsey to the Washington County District Court, Springdale Department entails only additional duties, and jurisdiction in the Carroll County and Madison County District Courts, shall remain in Judge Ramsey to the same extent as though this assignment had not been made.
