## ORDER

Under the authority vested in the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Arkansas by Act 496 of 1965, as amended, Amendment 80 of the Arkansas Constitution, and Section 1 of Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 16, as amended, and in response to the written request of the Mississippi County District Court Clerk, the Hon. Teresa Smith, State District Court Judge, 30<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, Lonoke County District Court, Division 1, is hereby assigned to the Mississippi County District Court, Blytheville Department, to hear the following case:

*Tri-State Auto Sales, Inc. v. Stephanie Kirk* – CV-21-001

The assignment of Judge Smith to the Mississippi County District Court, Blytheville Department, shall include assignment to any additional cases scheduled on the court's conflict day due to the Mississippi County District Judge's recusal.

This assignment includes all ancillary proceedings which may arise in connection with said causes, and proceedings subsequent thereto shall be held at such time or times as shall be directed and ordered by Judge Smith.


