#### **DRUG COURT**

### **UNION COUNTY**

The Union County Drug Court program has been in operation since January 2002. Regular court sessions are conducted on the first Tuesday and third Thursday of each month at the Union County Criminal Justice Facility in El Dorado, Arkansas. The program primarily utilizes a post-adjudication process and is open to defendants who have committed eligible offenses, who have eligible continual histories and are recommended by the prosecutor. The Union County Drug Court operates under the statutory authority found in Ark. Code Ann. Section 16-98-301 et seq. This drug court conforms to all applicable sentencing laws, including but not limited to, fines, fees, court costs, and probation

assessments. The program receives staff from the Department of Community Corrections and funding from the collection of court fees and grants from city/county, state and federal sources when available.

The members of the drug court team include a circuit judge, the prosecuting attorney, the public defender, private defense counsel, treatment professionals, DCC staff and local court staff. The drug court team meets before each scheduled drug court day to staff each defendant within the drug court program, and more frequently as needed.
