ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

Kyle C. West, Arkansas Bar No. 2012292, an attorney practicing law primarily in Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas, is hereby placed on Interim Suspension.

A Petition for Interim Suspension was filed by Stark Ligon, Executive Director of the Office of Professional Conduct, pursuant to §16 of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law ("Procedures")(Rev. 2011), alleging that Mr. West has been found guilty of a Serious Crime and presently poses a substantial threat of serious harm to the public or to his client(s).

It is therefore ORDERED that the Arkansas law license of Kyle A. West be, and hereby is, SUSPENDED immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
