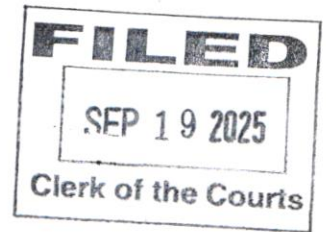

**ORDER OF MODIFIED INTERIM SUSPENSION  
[WITH STAYED SUSPENSION]**

Robert M. Brech, Executive Director of the Arkansas Supreme Court Office of Professional Conduct, and Quentin Ellery May (May), Respondent Attorney, *pro se*, have presented their Joint Petition to Modify Interim Suspension to Panel A of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct.

The Committee finds and orders as follows:

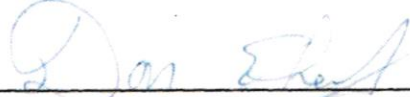
1.       That May has been on an interim suspension since September 16, 2022, pursuant to the Order of Interim Suspension entered by Panel A of the Committee.
2.       That the parties reached and executed a consent agreement in this matter, as well as other previously pending matters.
3.       That May admitted his violations of Rules 1.15(a)(5), 1.4(a)(3), 8.1(b), and 8.4(c) of the Arkansas Rules of Professional Conduct.
4.       That, upon entry of this Order, the interim suspension will be modified so May will serve a [stayed] suspension, which will be automatically dissolved on September 16, 2027.
5.       That, upon entry of this Order through the remainder of the [stayed] suspension, May will be working under the supervision of an attorney who will provide quarterly reports to OPC.
6.       That, upon entry of this Order, May will allow the supervising attorney to administer any IOLTA-related funds for the remainder of the [stayed] suspension and will not personally utilize or maintain an IOLTA in his own name.

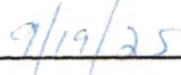
7. That non-compliance with this Order will subject May to further disciplinary proceedings consistent with the Procedures.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Respondent Quentin Ellery May be, and hereby is, on a **STAYED SUSPENSION** from the entry of this Order until September 16, 2027.
