ORDER OF INTERIM SUSPENSION

Respondent Barry J. Jewell, Arkansas Bar ID #84081, an attorney practicing law primarily in Little Rock, Arkansas, was found guilty by a jury in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas, on August 13, 2008, in Case No. 07-CR-103, of Count 5 of the Indictment, the criminal offense of Aiding and Abetting Tax Evasion, in violation of 26 U.S.C. § 7201 and 18 U.S.C. § 2, a felony. Mr. Jewell is awaiting sentencing. Any felony is a "serious crime" as defined in Section 2.J of the Supreme Court Procedures Regulating Professional Conduct of Attorneys at Law (Rev. 2002) (the "Procedures"). The United States District Court for the Eastern District of Arkansas entered its Order on September 23, 2008, suspending Mr. Jewell's privilege to practice law in that Court.

Panel B of the Arkansas Supreme Court Committee on Professional Conduct, upon presentation of a file marked copy of the jury verdict form, and other information and materials related to his conduct as an attorney, found that Respondent Jewell had been adjudicated guilty of a felony. By a majority vote, Panel B directs that Respondent Jewell's privilege to practice law in Arkansas should be suspended immediately under the provisions of Section 16(A)(2) and Section 17(E)(3)(b) of the Procedures, pending further disciplinary proceedings and action. It is therefore ORDERED that the privilege of BARRY J. JEWELL, to practice law in the courts of the State of Arkansas be SUSPENDED on an interim basis immediately upon the filing of this Order with the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court.
