<u>Warren Dept.</u> Bradley County Circuit Court cases - circuit court matters which are referred to the district judge under the Administrative Plan for the 10th Judicial District are heard on one day per month set aside by the District Judge for such matters; such matters are heard in the District Court courtroom in Warren, the record being preserved by use of BIS, Inc., Digital Recording Solutions software.
