Warren Dept., District Court cases - criminal cases are heard on first, second, and third Wednesdays and on the second Thursday of the month; civil cases are heard on the third Friday; first appearances, misdemeanor and felony, are heard as needed

Monticello Dept., Drew County Circuit Court cases - circuit court matters which are referred to the district judge under the Administrative Plan for the 10th Judicial District are heard on one of two days per month set aside by the District Judge for such matters; such matters are heard in the District Court courtroom in Monticello, the record being preserved by use of BIS, Inc., Digital Recording Solutions software.

Warren Dept., Bradley County Circuit Court cases - circuit court matters which are referred to the district judge under the Administrative Plan for the 10th Judicial District are heard on one day per month set aside by the District Judge for such matters; such matters are heard in the District Court courtroom in Warren, the record being preserved by use of BIS, Inc., Digital Recording Solutions software.
