Issuing a Warrant

There are multiple places that you can issue a warrant in Contexte.

- CCADREQ
- Session Direct or NMAMAIN
- CBAOPAY (Failure to Pay Warrants)
- CMAINIT (Affidavit or WI/WO Warrants)
- CDAOCON (Failure to Comply Warrants)



Most Common Mistakes

- Incorrect Cursor Location
- Failure to Verify before saving.
- Failure to enter a signed or produced date.
- Issuing a warrant on the wrong person.
- Creating a warrant directly from Letter Merge.
- Issuing a specific warrant from a different location.
 - FTP from CBAOPAY
 - FTC from CDAOCON

OOPS!!



Troubleshooting

I didn't put a signed or produced date in CCADREQ – How do I serve/track my warrant?

- You will need to know who you are searching for and can do a name search to find the case number to use to go back into CCADREQ to add the signed and/or produced date.



Troubleshooting

I entered the wrong docket code in CCADREQ when creating a warrant. Now I have an FTA Warrant with a FTC Docket Code. Can I correct this error?

- No. This is why the instructions state not to enter docket codes in this form or in COADTRA. If a correction is needed, it will have to go through Help Desk to be corrected. Docket codes need to be entered into CDADOCT.



Troubleshooting

The bond amount did not appear on my warrant. Why?

- The bail must be calculated on a case before a warrant is issued. Did you Bail Calc?
- Did you issue a FTC Warrant from somewhere other than CDAOCON or an FTP Warrant from somewhere other than CBAOPAY? This will cause the amount to not be correct on your warrant.

* If the Judge wants to change the amount of a warrant, simply adjust the amount on the warrant, as it is a Word document.
