Summary of Release:

The goals of SAVRY Release 2.0 are to primarily update the SAVRY application to allow end users at Department of Youth Services (DYS) to create and update SAVRY assessments in compliance with Act 189 of 2020 while also addressing several defects & enhancement requests.

The Arkansas SAVRY Application is a web-based application developed to replace the juvenile officers' utilization of Contexte in completing and managing SAVRY assessment data. This application interfaces with data stored in Contexte. Cases are created in the Contexte Application and then viewable to the juvenile officer in the SAVRY Application. The Arkansas SAVRY application incorporates policy and validity rules developed by the Administrative Office of the Courts Juvenile Division in conjunction with Dr. Gina Vincent, Associate Professor and Director of Translational Law and Psychiatry at the University of Massachusetts Medical School.

In this release the following functionality is addressed:

- o Update the application to work for end users at DYS
- o Add a new tab in Assessments titled "Change Party Status" which allows an end user to update the Juvenile's status to EXITDYS or DYS.
 - A party status of DYS exposes the Juvenile to DYS and EXITDYS indicates a Juvenile recently left DYS placement.
 - The idea is that upon SAVRY review, or after the fact, you may update the status to DYS to expose the Juvenile to end users at DYS.
- o Update the application to work for end users with access to multiple courts/locations
- o Add a "Download to Excel" export option in Case View.
