Data discovery, analysis and collaboration.

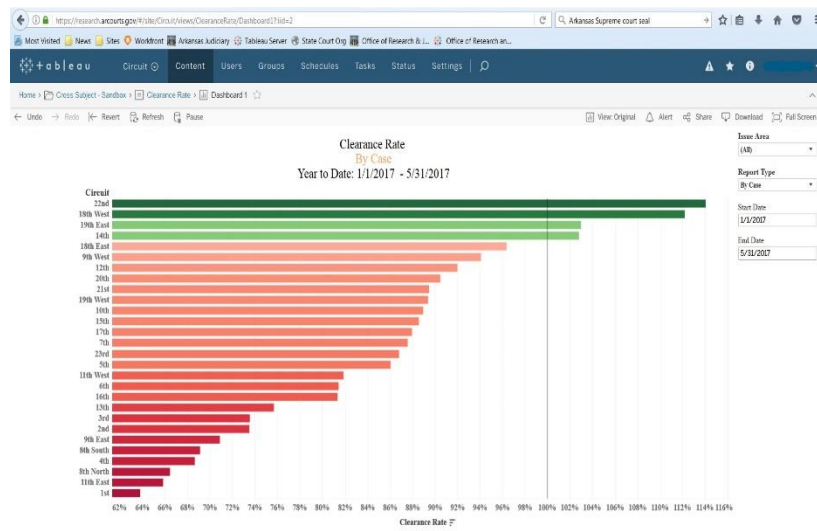

Dashboards created by the ORJS are available to you anytime, anywhere. Highlight and drill down to analyze and find answers to your data questions right in a browser. Dashboards are refreshed daily to contain the most up-to-date information. Dashboards currently on Tableau Server include:

- Summary Report
- Manner of Filing
- Manner of Disposition
- Age of Active Pending (with case detail)
- Clearance Rate
- Time to Disposition
