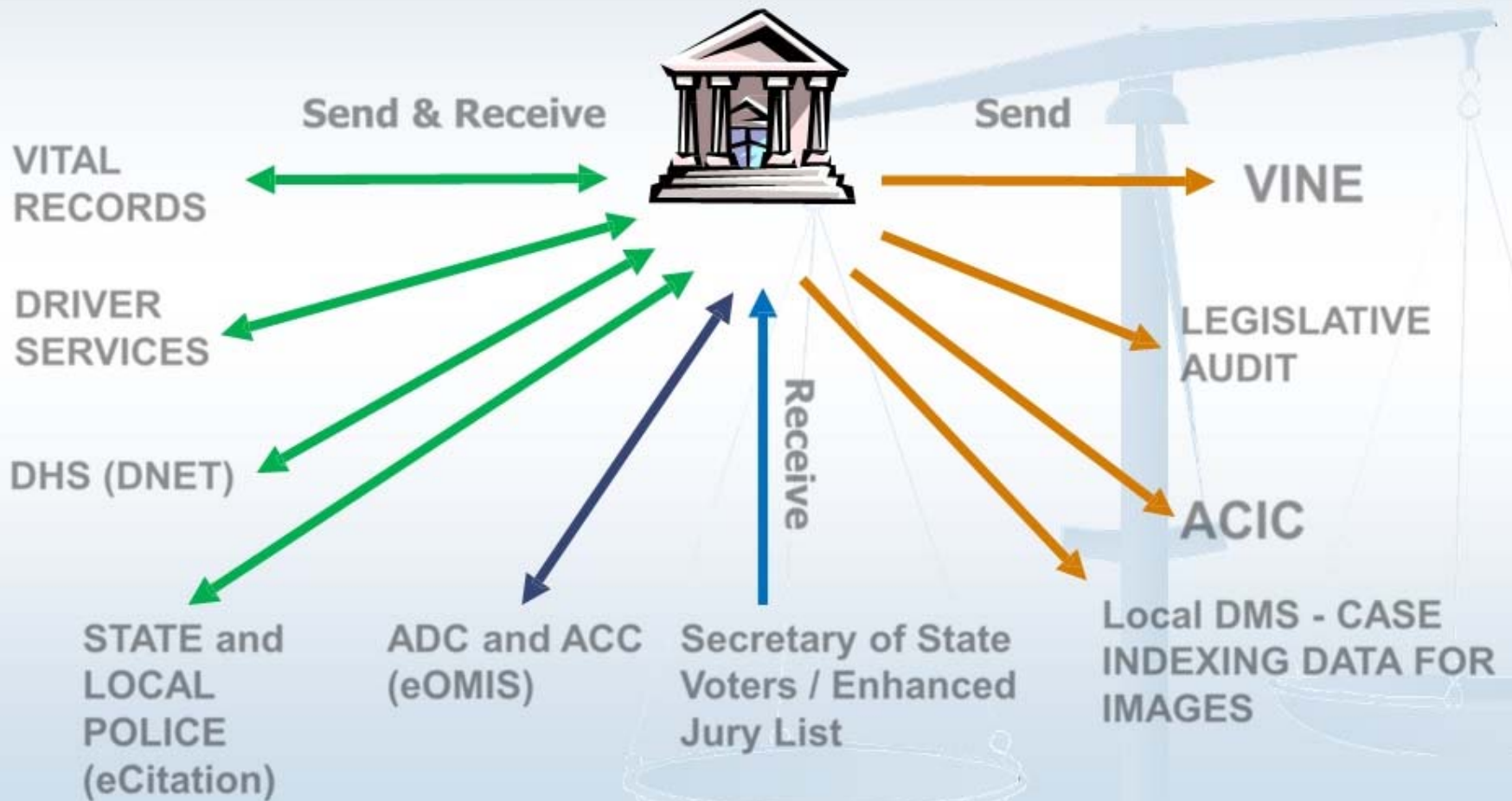

What Are the Changes in Data Exchanges?

Court and justice information is constantly changing. Mailing and even faxing information to ACIC and Driver Services is just too slow and too inaccurate for the 21st century. A principle goal of court automation is timely, accurate, and complete justice information being available to courts, law enforcement, and justice agencies. ACAP experts will discuss the current and coming data exchanges and tell users what buttons to push to make sure the right information is sent at the right time.

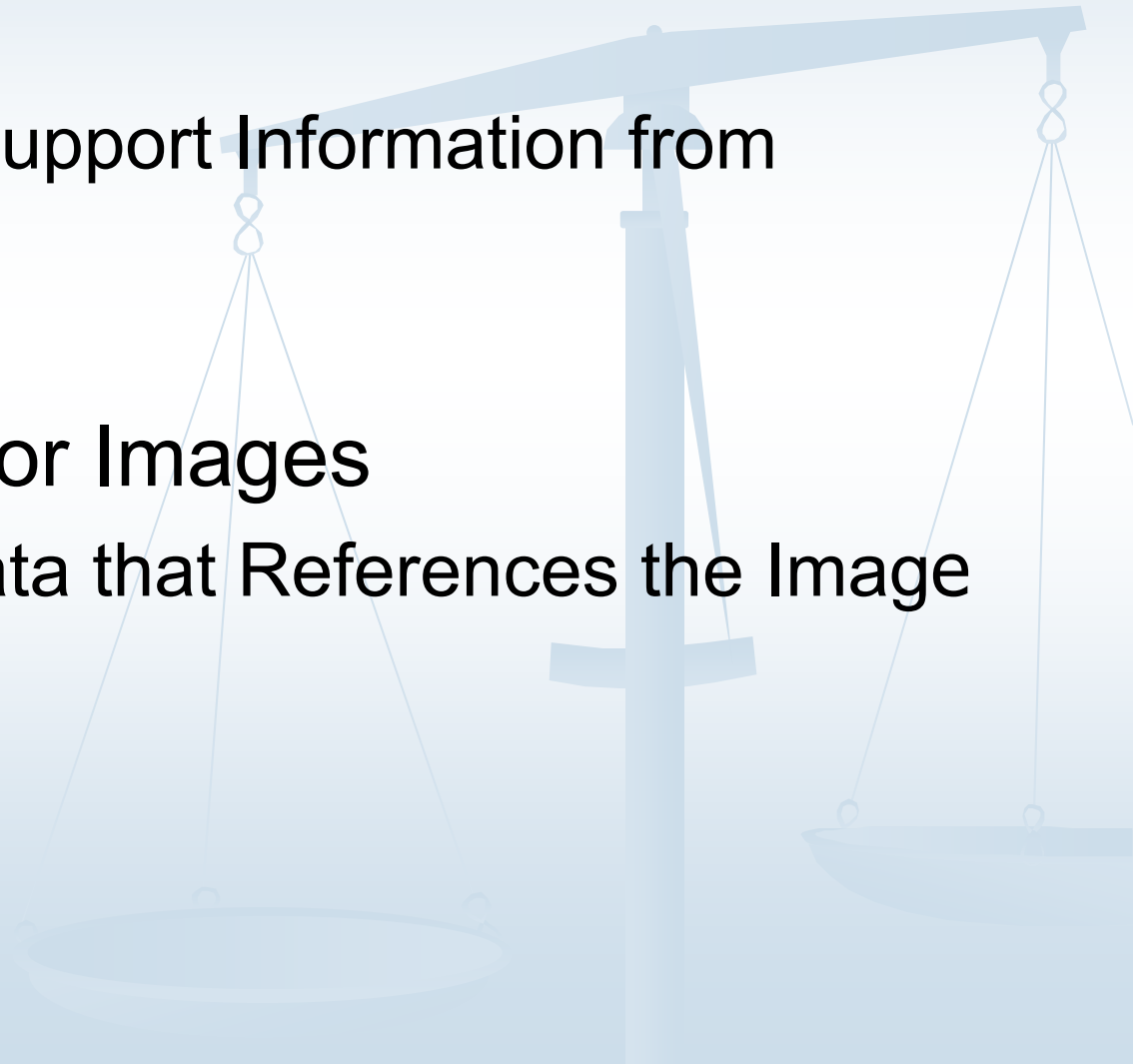
Overview of Data Exchanges



- **DHS (DNet)**
 - Used by Ad Litem and Judges/TCAs
 - Track Dependent Neglect Information
 - Data Stored in Contexte
- **Legislative Audit**
 - Accounting Data Provided from Contexte
 - Leg Audit Uses Data for Analysis
 - Data Pulled as Needed by Leg Audit

Overview of Data Exchanges

- OCSE
 - Provide Child Support Information from Contexte
 - Once a Month
- Case Indexing for Images
 - Provide Metadata that References the Image



Overview of Data Exchanges



- Secretary of State
 - Jury Voter Registration and Driver License Information
 - Once a Year with Monthly Updates
- eOMIS (ADC/ACC System)
 - In Progress
 - Share Criminal Information Between Agencies
 - Drug Court Information
 - Offender Status
 - Person Demographics
 - Sentencing Order Information
 - Warrant Information
 - Events
 - Frequency Unknown at this Time

VINE (Victim Information and Notification Everyday)




- AOC Provides Charge Disposition, Sentences, and Scheduled Event information
- Every 15 Minutes
- Register with VINE to Track Specific Cases or Defendants
 - www.vinelink.com
- Receive Notice of Custody, Parole/Probation, and/or Court Status Changes

Vital Records

- Deceased Dates Updated in Contexte if Field Blank
 - Once a Month
- Divorce/Annulment Coupons
 - Push Information
 - Once a Month – 5th of Each Month
 - Rejects Provided to Courts Monthly
 - Rejects Based Upon Required Data
 - Case/Person, Parties, DCINF COASITE Information

ACIC

- Push Criminal Conviction Data Containing an ATN
 - Every 2 – 3 Minutes
 - No ATN; No Record Can be Matched
 - Juvenile Data for Certain Charges Based Upon Age
 - Court, Arrest, Defendant Demographic, Charge, Plea, Disposition, Condition, Fine, and Restitution Information
 - ACIC Rejects

Driver Services




- Receive Driver Updates
 - People Data
 - Name Changes, New Drivers, Address Changes
 - Once a Week
- Send Moving Violations
 - Actions
 - Suspensions, Revocations, and Reinstatements
 - Convictions
 - Guilty, Guilty Bond Forfeiture Changes
 - Real Time

eCitation



- Receive Citation Data from CAPS (Center for Advanced Public Safety)
 - Developed by State of Alabama
 - Used by Arkansas Law Enforcement
 - All State Police Citations
 - Some Sheriff and Local Law Enforcement Agencies
 - AOC Pulls Daily (5 am and 7 am)
- Disposition Information from Contexte
 - CAPS Pulls Daily (7 am)

Why are These Exchanges Important?

- Public Safety
 - VINE
 - ACIC
 - Data Quality
 - Data Entered by Originator of Information
 - Removed Duplicate Entry
 - Faster and Less Costly Processing
 - Removed Paper, Postage, Envelopes, etc.
 - National Data Sharing of Statistical Data
