

Public Service Announcement from Ashley County District Court

District Judge Reid Harrod has announced that all nonessential court proceedings previously set from March 16, 2020 through March 27, 2020, will be suspended in response to the COVID-19 pandemic and recommendations by relevant public officials. All cases set for March 24, 2020 are rescheduled to May 26, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. All cases set for March 25, 2020 are rescheduled for May 27, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. Cases set for Thursday March 26, 2020 are reset for May 28, 2020 at 1:30. Court staff will be present in the District Court Clerks office to assist the public and can be reached by telephone at 870-364-7620. Alternatively, the court may be reached by email at crossett@ashleycountydistrictcourt.org.

The court will remain available for processing criminal warrants and for video conferencing with inmates for first appearances. The court will continue to review Petitions for Ex Parte Orders of Protection and other emergency matters. If you are on supervised probation please continue to call on your scheduled review date.
