Effective March 18, 2020 – May 1, 2020 (Subject to Extension) All in-person court proceedings are suspended in Mulberry District Court per Arkansas Supreme Court Per Curiam in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

All in-person court proceedings (court dates) during this time period will be reset for a new court date. Please regularly recheck our notices on the City of Mulberry Webpage (cityofmulberry.org) or the City of Mulberry Facebook page (Mulberry City Limits). You may also go to caseinfo.arcourts.gov to look up your new court date once it has been set.

If you would like to talk to the Mulberry Prosecuting Attorney about settling your case, you may call 479-632-2446. If you are represented by an attorney, you should contact your attorney directly. IF YOU HAVE BEEN APPOINTED A PUBLIC DEFENDER BY THE COURT, the Public Defender's phone number is 479-471-3270.

- 4. Drop Box available in front of Mulberry District Court at 207 N. Main Street Mulberry, AR 72947. Use personal check, money order or cashier's check.**

If you are on probation, alternative service or community service through our court, you must call Mulberry District Court at 479-997-1321 for updated instructions. All probation visits must be done by telephone instead of in person, but are still required. Certificates, or any other probation paperwork may be put in the drop box in front of District Court Building.
