No jury trials will be held in Garland County until after April 3, 2020. All jurors are directed to call the automated system on that day to confirm their next assignment.

All criminal matters, except jury trials, will be held as scheduled unless a written order from the court has been issued rescheduling the matter. Only defendants and necessary parties will be allowed to come into the Garland County Jail courtroom or the Garland County Courthouse courtrooms for these scheduled hearings. The courts will consider motions to continue these hearings for any attorneys involved or defendants if they are symptomatic or a part of the at-risk population as designated by the Department of Health and CDC websites.

Any civil/domestic/probate matters currently scheduled will be rescheduled until a later date. Please check with the Trial Court Administrators to reschedule these matters.

Juvenile case inquiries are directed to Judge Naramore's notice on this website. Also, inquiries can be made to his Trial Court Administrator.

Dependency/Neglect cases will be held as scheduled. Any questions about scheduled hearings can be directed to the Trial Court Administrator in that division.
