AS A MATTER OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN RESPONSE TO THE OUTBREAK OF COVID-19, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY:

All First Appearances and Trials (Criminal, Civil, and Small Claims) scheduled in the Maumelle District Court shall be continued until after April 1, 2020. All cases will be reset and the regular Court docket will resume Tuesday, April 7, 2020. If you have a case in Maumelle, please contact the Maumelle District Court at 501-851-7800 for a new court date. If your case involves a minor traffic violation (Speeding, No Insurance, Running a Stop Sign, etc., with no accident, you may plead **Guilty** and go online to pay. If you choose to plead **Not Guilty**, please follow the information above and contact our court.

Please note that attorneys are welcome to contact the Court in the event they take issue with the delay and said concerns will be addressed on a case by case basis. Additionally, the Court will continue to have video court for those defendants that are incarcerated in the Pulaski County Detention Center.
