In accordance with the Arkansas Supreme Court's recent *per curiam* orders, Thirteenth Division Circuit Court has been using the Zoom teleconferencing program for all hearings.

The Pulaski County Courthouse remains closed to the public by Executive Order of Pulaski County Judge Barry Hyde. This is for the safety of the public and staff.

All matters that are currently set for hearing will be heard via Zoom teleconferencing or in-person at a later time once the Courthouse reopens. If you have resolved your case by agreement you may submit a Proposed Order through the E-filing system for review. In addition, all uncontested divorces may be heard by deposition submitted with a proposed Decree through the e-file system.

Thirteenth Division will continue to use Zoom for all hearings until at least June 1st.
