

## 22<sup>ND</sup> JUDICIAL CIRCUIT ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN AMENDMENT

Judge-Elect Ken Casady took the bench in the 1<sup>st</sup> Division of our Judicial Circuit on January 1, 2019, after having served twelve years as the elected Prosecuting Attorney for this judicial district. In order to avoid any conflicts or the appearance of any conflict with cases currently pending which have been prosecuted under his name, the circuit judges of this district have approved the following amendments to our Administrative Plan. Changes are underlined.

### III. Circuit Court Administrative Plan

#### A. Division of Cases

##### 1. 1<sup>st</sup> Division

- a. Domestic Relations 80%
- b. Criminal 0% until 7/1/2019 then 50% of *new files*
- c. OCSE/Child Support 100% (formerly under 3<sup>rd</sup> Division)

##### 2. 2<sup>nd</sup> Division

- a. Criminal 50% then 35% of *new files* as of 7/1/2019
- b. Civil 40%
- c. DHS Dependency/Neglect 100%
- d. Hope Court (primary judge)

##### 3. 3<sup>rd</sup> Division

(1<sup>st</sup> Division criminal cases open as 1/1/19 will be transferred to 3<sup>rd</sup> Division.)

- a. Criminal 50% of new filings until 7/1/2019,  
then 15% of new files thereafter
- b. Civil 60%
- c. Adult Drug Court 100%

##### 4. 4<sup>th</sup> Division

- a. Probate 100%
- b. Domestic Relations 20%
- c. Delinquency/FINS 100%
- d. Hope Court (secondary judge)
- e. Administrative Judge
