ORDER TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE THE RECORD

Before the court is a motion pursuant to Rule 5 (b) of the Rules of Appellate Procedure – Civil to extend the time to file the record on appeal in order for the court reporter to include stenographically reported material. The court makes the following findings:

1. _____ (“Appellant”) has filed a motion explaining the reasons for the requested extension.
2. Appellant has served the motion on all counsel of record and pro se parties.
3. The time to file the record on appeal has not yet expired.
4. All parties have had the opportunity to be heard on the motion [at a hearing held on the matter on _____, 20__] [and/or] [by filing a response to the motion].
5. Appellant, as required by Rule 6(b) of the Rules of Appellate Procedure – Civil, has timely ordered the stenographically reported material from the court reporter and made any financial arrangements required for its preparation.
